

Gulf of Mexico Named Windstorm Exclusion Endorsement

This Endorsement attaches to and forms part of the policy ("Policy") to which it is attached.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained elsewhere in the Policy, the Policy also excludes loss, damage, liability, cost or expense of whatsoever nature otherwise insured or reinsured caused by or resulting from any Named Windstorm or Named Windstorm Occurrence of such Named Windstorm whose Storm Center originates in or migrates into the Gulf of Mexico, where

"Gulf Of Mexico" means the portion of the Atlantic Basin bounded on the northeast, north and northwest by the states of Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, and Florida, on the southwest and south by Mexico, on the southeast by Cuba and between Mexico and Cuba by a line drawn between Chetumal, Quintana Roo, Mexico and La Jagua, Cuba and between Cuba and Florida by a line drawn between Santa Clara, Cuba and Miami, Florida, and

"Storm Center" means (1) for any cyclonic Named Windstorm the point of lowest barometric pressure at the surface within the Named Windstorm's central area, or (2) for all other Named Windstorms the center of the area covered by the Named Windstorm.
